DONATIONS

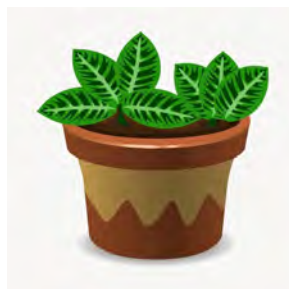
