



UNIFORM POLICY

At Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School we are proud and committed to wearing our school uniform with pride. Our school offers a uniform service providing a fully stocked uniform shop to meet all your uniform requirements from K-6.

- The school uniform must be worn by **all school children**.
- From Kindergarten to grade 2, children wear the sports uniform five days a week (Kinder children wear the uniform for three days).
- Grades 3-6 children will wear formal uniform 3 days each week, sports uniform on their designated sport day and every Friday.

All students	<p>School Badge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ School badge sewn on the left hand side of the green school jumper. <p>Hats:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Red bucket hats for boys and girls in Term 1 and Term 4 (not Term 2 & 3) - available from the school office or uniform shop. <p>Marking Clothes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ All clothes must be clearly marked with the child's name so that in the event of loss, they are clearly recognisable. Misplaced clothing items will be placed in the Lost Property basket located in the administration area. <p>Swimming Caps</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Students in grades 3-6 participating in the school swimming carnival need to wear a swim cap in their house colour, available to purchase from the school office. <p>Hair Styles:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Hair styles on all students should always be kept clean, neat and tidy. ✓ Hair below collar length is to be secured in a ponytail or pigtails with red, green or tartan ribbon not gold hair ribbons. <p>Jewellery:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ No costume jewellery or nail polish is to be worn to school. Students may wear watches, plain stud or sleeper earrings for pierced ears, necklace with a cross. <p>School Backpacks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Small and Large backpacks with the school logo are available (Kinder is optional) ✓ Suggested options: small size suits P-2, large size suits grades 3-6. <p>School Jumpers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ School jumpers are to be worn by all students when departing school. During summer period, students will be advised of the removal of jumpers according to daily temperatures. <p>Uniform Transition Periods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Winter uniform: last week of term 1 ✓ Summer uniform: last week of term 3 ✓ All students are to be wearing the correct uniform at the beginning of each term. <p>Optional uniform items</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Items that can be purchased from the uniform shop are green winter coats, beanies, scarves, gloves, smocks, library and swim bags.
