## COVID 19 Update

Thanks to families for your continued support of our school in the past 6 months. These last 6 months have certainly been some of the strangest and at times most challenging I've experienced in my years in education. One of the great strengths of our school is the regular contact that parents have with our staff and the involvement parents have in our community events.

Our staff are very aware that there have been many events this year that have either been cancelled or have had no parental involvement. Each one of our decisions at SHS has been informed by advice from Catholic Education Tasmania (CET). Their decision making has been directly informed by the Health Department. If all of us had our way there would be no global pandemic and we would continue as in years past. 2020 has changed all of that and each one of us has been affected and had to make changes to our lifestyle. This year has taught us much about ourselves and in particular how we can support children in building their resilience.

In the past week there have been two events at school that have attracted a significant number of adults at school. The Band Soiree and Parent Student Teacher Conversations meant parents needed to follow COVID restrictions. It was pleasing to see families supportive of the requirements.

The recent outbreak in Melbourne is a reminder that COVID - 19 still poses a threat to our community. Outlined below is the most up to date COVID - 19 restrictions in accordance to our COVID -19 Safety Management Plan.

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## **COVID 19 Update**

The following arrangements are in place at Sacred Heart

Drop off and Pick up

- In term 3 we will continue to encourage parents to drop their children at the school gate.
- If parents urgently need to meet with teachers you can make time to meet after school on a Monday, Thursday or Friday.
- To make an appointment with your child's teacher, you can email them directly or phone the office to make contact.
- Any adults who enter our grounds will be required to write their name and leave their contact number at the Office. This will NOT include parents who enter the grounds at drop off and pick up time or parents who visit our Office. BUT will include any parents who make appointments with teachers.
- There will be NO Parent/Carer ENTRY into individual classrooms or classroom buildings (Kinder/Grade 6 Building, Grade 1/2 Building, Grade 3/4 Building, Grade 5/6 Building)
- Parents MUST NOT Congregate in groups.
- Kinder children and their siblings should be collected at 2.45pm from Margaret turning circle.
- These guidelines remain in play while we continue to observe social distancing rules. All adults must continue to practice Social Distancing guidelines of 1.5m.

## **Student Support**

We have ample support for students who may need support, being Belinda Flack our Catholic Care counsellor, and Megan Booth our Well Being Teacher. If you have any concerns about your child's wellbeing please contact your child's teacher.

### Gates

Our gates will remain locked during school hours, with exception of York Street entrance. We ask that you limit your access to our school grounds, and you must not enter the school grounds if you are unwell.

#### Illnesses

If your child is sick, your child must stay at home. If your child displays cold or flu symptoms at school, you will be contacted to collect them immediately.

## Cleaning and Hygiene

We continue to have the school professionally cleaned regularly. This includes regular wiping of high touch areas.

We will continue to have students and staff wash their hands at least three times a day and after every visit to the toilet.

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## **Social Distancing**

Children are not required to socially distance themselves.

All adults must continue to practice Social Distancing guidelines of 1.5m.

Assemblies will be available via a Zoom invite for parents. Parents will not be able to attend in person.



#### WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

#### **How to apply for a WWVP and Number**

- 1.Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\_with\_children
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
