Behavioural Goals

'To change a habit, make a conscious decision, then act out the new behaviour.' (Maxwell Maltz)

It is our goal at all times to support and improve the behaviour of all the children at Sacred Heart. To do so we acknowledge the critical role that parents play in supporting SHS to achieve our goal.

There is a strong relationship between behaviour and learning, children learn better in a positive environment. Equally, children who are stimulated in their learning through high quality, effective teaching and children who have their progress and achievements recognised will feel valued and motivated to achieve more.

In 2020 we challenged the children of SHS to consider what aspect of their behaviour 'needed work'. Each child was asked to reflect on what would make the biggest difference to the way they interacted at school. In the past week we have revisited this with children. Some of the goals children have agreed to work on include...

- · I will put my hand up more in class
- I will use better eye contact when I'm talking to people
- I will include others in my games
- I will commence tasks promptly
- I will focus on improving my own behaviour
- I will keep my hands to myself
- I will remember to wait for my turn
- I will listen when others speak to me
- I will remember to put my hand up when I have a question
- I will complete my work neatly
- I will make sure that I look after my belongings
- I will share my ideas with others in group activities
- I will use my best manners
- I will greet people when I see them
- I will be a Go Kart in class

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The children of SHS will be working on these goals in the weeks ahead. Ask your child how they are progressing? Consider how you can support them. As parents we can show our vulnerability by sharing the goals we are working on or have worked on in the past.

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

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

- 1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- 3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded
