Playground and SHS Avenue

In 2017 Sacred Heart identified the need to redvelop our playspaces. We began a period of consultation with all members of our community staff, students and parents. This consultation was shared with a Playground Designer, Miriam Sheveland, Playstreet.

The SHS Board made plans to stage a number of projects over a 5 year period.


- Stage 1 2018 - New Playground installed near the church. This playground cost approximately \$250,000. Supported by \$90,000 P and F funds.
- Stage 2 2020 - All weather surface installed on middle court. This space cost approximately \$50,000, Supported by \$15,000 P and F funds
- Stage 3 2022 - New Grade 3/4 Playground. Approximate costs \$200,000. Supported by \$25,000 P and F funds.

Our school has spent approximately \$500,000 on playgrounds in the last 5 years to provide exciting, challenging and appealing spaces for children to play. Included with this newsletter is a concept map of the 3/4 Playspace.

We are hopeful this new playspace will be complete by the end of 2022.

Last year we also submitted a funding proposal for SHS Avenue to Catholic Education Tasmania . The project was designed to address the pathways and areas around Block B and C (Grade 3/4 Classrooms and Grade 5). Our school was successful in in obtaining the grant of approximately \$500,000. The funds provided by Catholic Education Tasmania (CET) were accessed from the fund all parents contribute to via their Capital Levy contributions. This project will be developed simultaneously with the playground.

Included with this newsletter is a 3D drawing of the works for SHS Avenue.


PROTECTING YOURSELF AND OTHERS FROM CORONAVIRUS

Do you have any cold or flu-like symptoms?

This includes fever, runny nose, cough, sore/itchy throat or shortness of breath.

Call your GP or the Public Health Hotline 1800 671 738 to request a COVID-19 test



You must have a referral to be tested.

If there is no testing clinic in your local area, you can travel outside your municipality to have a test.

After being tested, you must self-isolate at home until you receive your results.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
