#### Covid update

Please be aware of the updated COVID Safety plan from CET.

- If your child is unwell please keep them at home
- Positive cases are still required to isolate for at least 7 days.
- Close contacts are still required to follow close contact rules for 7 days including testing daily if leaving their home and wearing a mask (all persons 12 years and older) in indoor settings when outside their home.
- RATS are available at the office if you need them
- Face masks are no longer required to be worn in schools, early childhood centres or on
  public transport unless the person is a close contact however, Public Health strongly
  encourages people to wear a face mask indoors where they cannot physically distance
  themselves or if they are at a higher risk of respiratory illness like COVID-19 and influenza.
- The reinfection exclusion period has been reduced from 12 weeks to 28 days. People who
  have symptoms of COVID-19 within 28 days following their release from isolation do not
  need to test and isolate for 7 days.

#### **Confirmed cases**

Should a student or member of staff test positive for COVID-19 they must:

- Please continue to inform us if your child tests positive or is a close contact
- Isolate for a minimum of 7 days, provided outside the 28-day reinfection exclusion period.
- Isolate for a further 3 days if they still have symptoms on day 7.
- If test positive using a rapid antigen test, register the result with Public Health using their online declaration form or phone the Public Health Hotline 1800 671 738.
- Notify household close contacts of the need to observe close contact requirements when leaving their homes.



## Outdoor Play and Learning

Catholic Education Tasmania supports schools in offering children creative play and learning within our outdoor spaces through our Outdoor Play and Learning Policy.



- Support learning and creative play with reasonable levels of risk-taking.
- Offer age appropriate activities and items to encourage development of gross motor, collaboration and risk assessment skills.
- Enable children to extend their capabilities.

Examples of potential activities with suitable risk controls include:

- Loose parts imaginative play & building.
   e.g. Logs, sticks, milk crates, rocks, tyres, mud play, etc
- · Limited tree climbing / play
- · Approved items disassembled
- · Fire pit usage & tricycles ridden without helmets





#### **WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION**

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

#### How to apply for a WWVP and Number

- 1. Complete the online application form <a href="https://www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\_with\_children">www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\_with\_children</a>
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- 3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
