Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School was founded 149 years ago by the Presentation Sisters. In the ensuing years the Presentation Sisters and the Christian Brothers shaped the culture and values of our school. Our school is fortunate to be founded by two charisms, two unique groups of sisters and brothers that have instilled their way of being in our school. Our school is proud of the traditions and values that have been evident from the very beginning in 1873.

Four years ago Sacred Heart initiated a new tradition. Our Leadership Team had a dream to provide the senior students of our school with a pilgrimage. We were eager to provide the Grade 6 children with an opportunity to experience a journey where they were given times to reflect. Our goal was to gift the children an opportunity to



# Do you have any cold or flu-like symptoms?

This includes fever, runny nose, cough, sore/itchy throat or shortness of breath.

Call your GP or the Public Health Hotline 1800 671 738 to request a COVID-19 test



You must have a referral to be tested.

If there is no testing clinic in your local area, you can travel outside your municipality to have a test.

After being tested, you must self-isolate at home until you receive your results.

## **WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION**

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

#### How to apply for a WWVP and Number

- 1. Complete the online application form <u>www.justice.tas.gov.au/working with children</u>
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- 3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
