## Building Works

In 2021 Sacred Heart was successful in its building application. The works on this project will commence on Tuesday 14th March and are due to be completed by the end of Term 3.

The project works include

- Addressing the varying levels of pathways, steps and egress around B Block (Grade 3/4 Classrooms)
- Installation of a ramp from the outside of the Old Assembly Hall
- Revitalisation of the Grade 3/4 Playground. This includes maintaining the current piece of equipment and installing new equipment.

The project has been funded by

- Catholic Education Systemic Building funds (all families contribute to this via our building levy)
- SHS Parents and Friends (contributed \$25,000 to the playground)
- SHS school funds

A secure area will be created around the outside of B Block resulting in our students and staff needing to access other parts of the school in different but safe ways.

- The top gate will not be accessible for our community for the duration of the process.

Our school has undergone a number of building projects over many years. Building projects mean disruption and often increased noise and traffic. Our prime goal is for the project to be completed safely. This means that we need our community to accept things will be different for a while. Thanks in anticipation of your patience and understanding.

We will keep families updated on the progress of our project.

On ANZAC Day students are invited to participate in the ANZAC Day March.

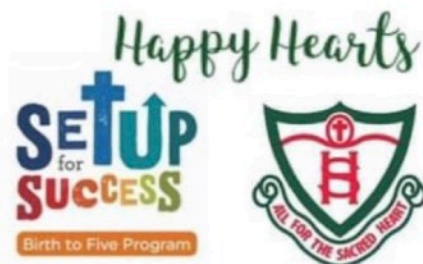

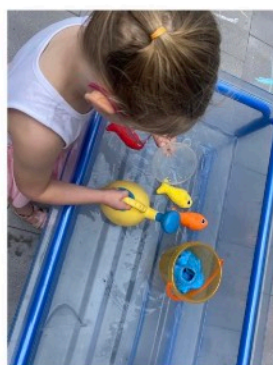
Our SETUP for Success program 'Happy Hearts' has made a great start to 2023.



**WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION**

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

**How to apply for a WWVP and Number**

1. Complete the online application form [www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\\_with\\_children](http://www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children)
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

**Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.**
