Celebrating 150 Years

Last year Catholic Education Tasmania, under our systemic strategic plan, launched the initiative Insight into Learning. The goal for our system is to be the most improved system in Australia.

Our teachers are undergoing intense Professional Learning to upskill their knowledge and pedagogy. This year three of our Pupil Free Days are devoted to Insight into Learning.

Last week our school had the Insight coaches work at our school. They spent time with our Instructional Leaders, Katelyn, Tegan, Lilia and Penelope, along with our Team Leaders and Leadership Team.

This year our Instructional Leaders will be provided with additional PL to support their needs.

All teaching staff will be spending significant time engaged in Professional Learning with the ultimate goal to support student learning.

The coaching models for both primary and secondary schools have been designed to build capacity across your schools with Instructional Leaders: Teacher Practice (ILTP) educators trained on the school site.

As the project develops into 2024 and beyond, we will build the capacity of each ILTP educator to coach our future waves of participants. This sets us up for a strong and sustained teaching approach into the future.

We are confident *Insight* is delivering knowledge, understanding and skills acquisition, measured by a change in long term memory. We want every one of your students to achieve surface to deep to transfer and retrievability of knowledge.

• *Insight* will enable this through targeted professional learning that supports Principals and Leaders to implement high impact, evidence informed teaching instruction based on the Science of Learning.

• Teachers will have access to Professional Learning, coaching and resources to implement the Science of Learning in all classrooms.

• Literate Learners for Life will continue to embed the Science of Reading principles in all classrooms.

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






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Birth to Five Program

You must have a referral to be tested.

If there is no testing clinic in your local area, you can travel outside your municipality to have a test.

After being tested, you must self-isolate at home until you receive your results.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

- 1. Complete the online application form <u>www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children</u>
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- 3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
