## Uniform Survey

Earlier this term families and staff completed a Uniform Survey. Our Uniform Team, made up of P and F, Board, Staff and Uniform Shop representatives analysed the data and made recommendations to our SHS Board, as we do for any changes to uniform.

The survey received 153 responses, a positive survey response.

The following information was provided from the survey

- Girls Winter Uniform 82% responded positively or neutral
- Boys Winter Uniform 84% responded positively or neutral
- Girls Summer Uniform 92% responded positively or neutral
- Boys Summer Uniform 83% responded positively or neutral
- Rugby Top 83% responded positively or neutral
- Outer garment options -  
42% selected Hoodie, 32 % selected Rugby Top and 26% selected Fleece Lined ¼ zipped jumper
- Outer Coat/Outer Jacket option -  
83% selected Fleece Lined soft shell jacket and 17% selected maintain current coat

The following decisions have been made by our School Board based on the information from the survey.

- Our Rugby Top will continue as our Sports Uniform. This is a compulsory item of our Sports Uniform and must be purchased by all families.
- There will be no change to the Sports Uniform
- We will be providing two choices for our outer coat/outer jacket for families - Current Coat **AND** Fleece Lined soft shell jacket. The new Fleece Lined soft shell jacket will have a school emblem included. These are optional items.
- Commencing 2025 children will only be permitted to wear the current Coat **OR** SHS Fleece Lined soft shell jacket. No other coats or jackets will be permitted with our school uniform. This allows families 18 months to make any changes.
- Our Uniform Policy will be changed to reflect these decisions

Thanks to the families who responded to the survey. Thanks to the Uniform Team for interrogating the survey data.

# Wellbeing Lessons



## FRIENDOLOGY

This week in our Primary Wellbeing Lessons, we are exploring healthy and unhealthy friendships.

We agree that healthy friendships are built on trust and respect. In these relationships we feel safe, happy and relaxed, allowing us to have fun together. We also treat each other with kindness and compassion.

We have determined that unhealthy friendships can feel uncomfortable and may involve us feeling powerless, unsafe or hopeless. There may be a lack of respect and a disregard for each other's feelings.

In Friendology, we learn that no friendship is perfect. All friendships can have ups and downs and occasional friendship fires don't necessarily mean that a friendship is unhealthy.

Here at Sacred Heart, we are empowering students to demonstrate the values and characteristics of a good friend, while using discernment to recognise an unhealthy friendship. We are practising our Friendship Ninja Skills when resolving conflicts. Our goal is to be friendly to all of our peers while accepting that friendships can change as we grow and change - and that's ok!

Here you can see some of our grade 5 students role playing how they identify and navigate healthy and unhealthy friendships.

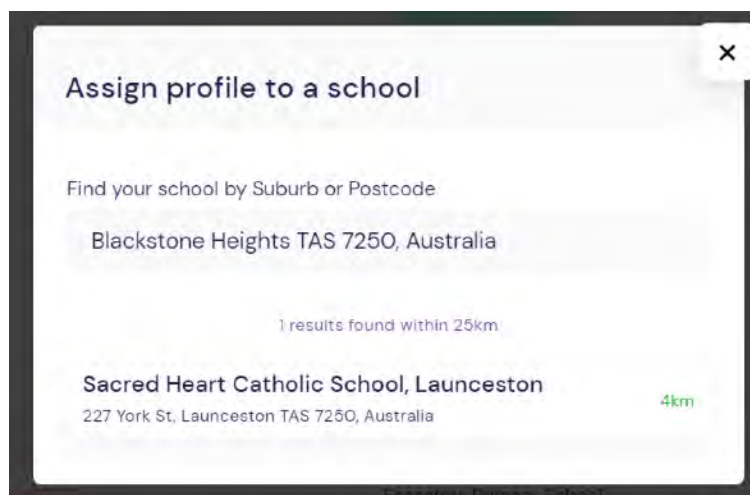

**How to apply for a WWVP and Number**

1. Complete the online application form [www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\\_with\\_children](http://www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children)
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

**Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.**
