Easter....

Easter Sunday, is the most significant liturgical event in our Catholic faith, holds deep-rooted traditions and historical significance. Easter Sunday derives its name from the Old English word 'Āstre', which is believed to be derived from the name of a pagan goddess associated with spring and fertility. Over time, the Christian holiday of Easter became intertwined with these pagan traditions, symbolising rebirth and renewal.

By understanding the origins, significance and history behind Easter Sunday, one gains a deeper appreciation for the values it represents and the traditions that have been passed through the centuries.

Easter Sunday commemorates the resurrection of Jesus Christ. It symbolises hope, redemption and the victory of life over death. The Easter season is a time of spiritual reflection, renewal and celebration within the Christian community.

The history of Easter Sunday dates back to the early days of Christianity when it was established as a commemoration of the resurrection of Jesus, considered the cornerstone of our faith. The day signifies the triumph of light over darkness and the promise of salvation for believers.

Throughout history, various traditions have become associated with Easter Sunday, including the Easter Bunny, Easter eggs and Easter parades. These customs have both religious and secular origins, symbolising themes of new life, fertility and rebirth.

Easter's Sacred Colours. These symbolic colours - purple, white and red - mix together to paint the true meaning of Easter. They are symbols of preparation, celebration and sacrifice. They remind us of the journey from reflection to the joyous celebration of new life and endless love. Purple is the colour that represents royalty and repentance. White shines brightly on Easter Sunday. This colour is about purity, new life and victory. Red is powerful and demands attention. It symbolises the sacrifice and love of Jesus, especially his death on the cross.

The spirit of Easter is one of joy, hope and unity.


HOW TO ORDER:






COVID-19 testing for all Tasmanian residents

Do you have any cold or flu-like symptoms?

This includes fever, runny nose, cough, sore/itchy throat or shortness of breath.

Call your GP or the Public Health Hotline 1800 671 738 to request a COVID-19 test



You must have a referral to be tested.

If there is no testing clinic in your local area, you can travel outside your municipality to have a test.

After being tested, you must self-isolate at home until you receive your results.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

- 1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working-with-children
- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- 3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
