Tasmanian non-Government schools are mandated to undergo ongoing registration with the School Registration Board (SRB). We are required to share with the SRB a range of documents. Some of these documents include what we are teaching, who our staff are and their qualifications, our school strategic plans, a seemingly endless list of WHS documents and many other relevant pieces of information. The process of undergoing registration is an affirming one as it allows us to share the many celebrations our school is proud of.

- **Mutual Respect:** Recognizing the valuable role both parents and teachers play in a child's education.

We are committed to strengthening this partnership and will continue to explore ways to involve parents in a meaningful way.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
